1.0 INTRODUCTION

1.1 Purpose of Procurement

The White County Board of Commissioners is requesting sealed proposals from qualified vendors for veterinarian and spay/neuter services for White County Animal Control.

1.2 Proposal Certification

Pursuant to the provisions of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated § 50-5-67(a), White County certifies that the use of competitive sealed proposals will be practical or advantageous to the County in completing the acquisition described in this document.

The owner shall have the right to waive any informality, irregularity, or insufficiency in the proposal procedure and in any proposal or proposals received, and to accept the proposal which, in the Owner's sole judgment, is in the Owner's own best interest. The Owner shall have the right to accept any proposal.

1.4 Restrictions on Communications

From the issue date of this RFP until a vendor is selected and the award is announced, contractors are not allowed to communicate about this project with any County staff or elected officials except: 1) through the Public Safety Director named herein, 2) at the Pre-Proposal Meeting (if applicable to project), or 3) as provided by existing work agreement(s). The County reserves the right to reject the submittal of any vendor violating this provision.

No response to inquiries, other than written, will be binding upon the County. White County reserves the right to issue written addenda to any inquiries that alter the scope of the RFP. Addenda shall be posted to the county website, www.whitecounty.net under the Bids/RPFs page no later than 5:00 PM, August 22, 2018. A signed copy of any addenda shall accompany submitted proposals. Contractors are advised to check the website for addenda before submitting their proposals.

1.6 Contract Term

The initial contract term between the County and the contractor shall be from October 1, 2018 to September 30, 2019 and will be eligible for up to two (2) annual renewals.

The County and the Contractor shall negotiate potential renewals for the fourth through the sixth years' contract beginning with the submission in writing by the Contractor of its proposed cost for the next year by August 1, 2021. If the County and the Contractor cannot agree on an amount by August 9, 2021, this Agreement shall be cancelled.

White County reserves the right to terminate contract, with 30 days written notice, for any violations in the terms of this agreement, rules, laws or unreconciled issues arising as a result of this agreement. Vendor agrees to provide 30 days written notice and complete any ongoing activity period if Vendor chooses to opt out of an agreement with the County.

Proposal 2018-ACO-001, Spay/Neuter Veterinary Service Contract

White County Government is soliciting sealed proposals from qualified firms or individuals on contract for spay/neuter and veterinarian services for the White County Animal Shelter (WCAS). Please submit one original and two (2) copies of the proposal. Incomplete proposal or proposals that do not conform to the requirements specified herein will not be considered. Issuance of the RFP does not obligate White County to award a contract, nor is White County liable for any costs incurred by the offeror in the preparation and submittal of proposals for the subject work. White County retains the right to award all or parts of this contract to more than one offeror, to not select any offerors, and/or to resolicit proposal. The offeror is responsible to inform himself/herself fully of the conditions relating to the requirements of this proposal and become familiar with all the proposal documents and contract documents.

I. BACKGROUND

The White County Animal Shelter (WCAS) located at 680 Industrial Blvd. Cleveland, GA. 30528 provides a wide range of services to White County residents and their pets. The WCAS provides field services seven days a week, to White County. These services include the enforcement of the White County ordinance related to animals, impoundment of stray pets and investigation of animal-related neglect, cruelty, nuisance and bite cases. The WCAS houses domestic animals from White County. It provides, not only a safe haven for these homeless pets, but also adoption and transfer services, advice on animal-related topics, lost and found pet reports and low-cost spay/neuter clinics for White County residents' dogs and cats.

As a full service municipal animal care and animal control agency, the WCAS is responsible for the enforcement of local and state laws, throughout White County. The WCAS is an open door facility accepting approximately 1,500 stray and homeless animals annually.

Currently, White County provides low income spay/neuter clinics to citizens of White County. Approximately 230 dogs and cats were spayed or neutered in the 2017-2018 fiscal year, both adopted animals and by public clinics.

On behalf of the WCAS, White County is soliciting proposals from qualified organizations to provide spay/neuter veterinary services, and enter into a Professional Services Agreement with White County. The successful Vendor will be expected to perform the services listed below.

II. SCOPE OF WORK

1. Spay and Neuter Veterinary Services

Veterinarian services may include, but is not limited to, providing history and physical to spay/neuter patients, performing lab work related to spay/neuter patients, performing spay and neuter surgeries to animals of White County, providing guidance to staff on follow-up treatment, diet and behavioral issues. Weekly services may include approximately 10 spay/neuter clinic surgeries, medical exams of spay/neuter clinic patients and lab work related to spay/neuter clinic patients. WCAS staff will provide transportation back and forth for animals to the veterinary site.

2. Veterinarian of Record for Veterinary License

The Contractor shall be the veterinarian of record for the purpose of maintaining a current Veterinary License with the State of Georgia. A copy of the veterinarian's current state license shall be posted at the WCAS and remain on file with White County.

3. Training Shelter Staff

Contractor agrees to provide training to the WCAS Staff and Enforcement Officers in the areas of Animal first aid, neglect, infectious diseases and euthanasia when necessary.

4. Veterinarian of Record for Supply Distributors

Contractor shall act as the Veterinarian of Record for the purpose of ordering medical supplies, and vaccines for WCAS.

5. Co-sign for the Shelter's Controlled Drugs

The contractor must be licensed to act as co-signer for the purchase of controlled drugs at the WCAS as required by the Drug Enforcement Administration. Contractor will supervise handling and recording of controlled substances. Contractor must maintain a current license to be kept on file with White County.

6. Vaccinations

Veterinarian will vaccinate dogs, cats, livestock or other animals that are placed with the public, either by adoption or by being returned to their owners for Rabies only.

7. Vaccination Clinic

Veterinarian will provide vaccination services for the annual Rabies Clinic. The Rabies Clinic offers vaccinations to the public at low cost.

8. Backup services

The Contractor must provide Relief/Backup Veterinary Services (RVTS) as needed and provide telephonic veterinary consulting for managing RVTS regarding the health of impounded animals in accordance with the State of Georgia. On occasion, an emergency situation will require the Contractor to provide direct consultation. The Contractor must provide coverage for times when the Contractor cannot be present for spay/neuter surgeries and/or RVTS.

III. SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

All proposals shall include the following information, organized as separate sections of the proposal. The proposal should be concise and to the point.

1. Contractor Identification:

Provide the name of the contractor, the contractor's principal place of business, and telephone numbers.

2. Client References:

Provide a minimum of 3 client references. Provide the designated person's name, title, organization, address, telephone number.

3. Price Proposal:

The proposal shall include pricing for all services. Pricing shall be all inclusive unless indicated otherwise on a separate pricing sheet. The Proposal shall itemize all services, including hourly rates for all professional services. Pricing form (Appendix C) is required for submitting pricing. No other form of pricing will be accepted. All other charges related to completion of the work shall be itemized.

4. Contract Terminations:

If you had a contract terminated in the last five years, describe such incident. Termination for default is defined as notice to stop performance due to the vendor's non-performance or poor performance and the issue of performance. Either (a) not litigated due to inaction on the part of the vendor, or (b) litigated and such litigation determined that the vendor was in default. Submit full details of the terms for default including the other party's name, address, and phone number. Present the vendor's position on the matter. The County will evaluate the facts and may, at its sole discretion, reject the proposal on the grounds of the past experience. If the firm has not experienced any such termination for default or early termination in the past five years so indicate.

5. Content of Proposal:

- Schedule of proposed hours for the Veterinarian and/or the Veterinarian Assistant.
- Copy of Georgia Veterinary License.
- Copy of Veterinarian Assistant Certification.
- Resume for the Veterinarian.
- Copy of current Drug Enforcement Agency (DEA) registration.
- Proof of Insurance (see Section VI).
- E-Verify Affidavit.
- Pricing Form, (Appendix C).
- Bidder Certification.

6. Minimum Qualifications:

The successful bidder shall possess a valid license to practice by the State of Georgia Veterinary Medical Board throughout the course of any potential agreement between White County and the bidder.

7. Process for Submitting Proposals

Preparation of Proposal:

Each proposal should be prepared simply and economically, avoiding the use of elaborate promotional materials beyond those sufficient to provide a complete presentation. If supplemental materials are a necessary part of the technical proposal, the Contractor should reference these materials in the technical proposal, identifying the document(s) and citing the appropriate section and page(s) to be reviewed.

Packaging of Proposal:

IV. SELECTION CRITERIA

The following criteria will be considered, although not exclusively, in determining which contractor is hired.

- 1. Cost: 75%
- 2. Depth and breadth of experience and expertise in spay/neuter clinic veterinary services: 10%
- 3. Responsiveness to the information requested in the RFP and demonstrated ability to perform the services described: 5%
- 4. References: 5%
- 5. Understanding of the contractual services required and a demonstrated history of providing similar services to comparable entities: 5%
- 6. A selection panel will be convened of White County. The panel shall include the WCAS department head, the WCAS Chief Enforcement Officer, an White County employee with specific expertise in the selection of a contractor, and a third party/FOTAS board member.

V. PAYMENT

Invoices: Invoices must be fully itemized, and provide sufficient information for approving payment and audit. Completed invoices will be submitted to White County Animal Services, 1241 Helen Highway, Suite 100, Cleveland, GA. 30528. Payment: White County will make payment to the vendor within 30-days of receipt of a correct and complete invoice.

VI. INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS

1. Contractor, performing as an independent contractor, shall be fully responsible for providing Workers Compensation, Commercial General Liability and Automotive Liability coverage as follows. Proof of Insurance and required affidavits must be included in proposal.

General Liability - \$1,000,000 General Liability with a combined single limit per occurrence of \$1,000,000, for bodily injury, personal injury, and property damage. *White County listed as additional insured.*

<u>Automobile Liability</u> - \$1,000,000 Automobile Liability combined single limit per accident, for bodily injury and property damage, when applicable. White County listed as additional insured.

<u>Workers' Compensation and Employers' Liability</u> - Worker's Compensation limits as required by the Labor Code of the State of Georgia.
