Your answer may be filed in writing or may be given orally to the **Clerk of Court**, but only in person within the 30 day period. **No telephone answers are permitted.** The court will hold a hearing upon the claim at the **White County Courthouse** located at **59 S. Main Street, Cleveland, GA 30528**, at a time to be set after your answer is filed. You may come with or without an attorney. If you have witnesses, books, receipts or any other writings bearing this claim, you should bring them with you at the time of the hearing. If you wish to have witnesses subpoenaed, contact the clerk's office at once for assistance. If you have a claim against the plaintiff, you should notify the clerk at once and file a written answer and counterclaim immediately. If you admit the claim but desire additional time to pay, you must come to the hearing in person and state the circumstances to the court.
