Outdoor LED Baseball Scoreboards Invitation To Bid Project# 2018-PR-001

Bid Closing Date: Friday, October 26, 2018

This addendum is issued to change or clarify the bid documents associated with the Outdoor LED Baseball Scoreboards Invitation to Bid, Issued October 5, 2018.

Q1. Are existing scoreboards being replaced by these scoreboards? If yes, will the City remove and discard the existing (old) scoreboard?

A1. No existing scoreboards – this is new construction.

Q2. Are there existing scoreboard support pylon/poles for these new scoreboards?

A2. No. As all of the scoreboards are new, support poles will be required to be installed along with the new scoreboards by the awarded vendor.

Q3. Are there drawings detailing the existing scoreboard support pylons/poles? If yes then please forward them to us.

a. 2 or 3 poles?

b. Pole material and sizes? Round poles? Square tubes? I or H beams?

A3. No. Since these are all new scoreboards, there are no drawings or details for any existing poles or supports as there are none.

Q4. Have the existing scoreboard supports (if any) been reviewed by the City Engineer for suitability with the new scoreboards?

A4. No. No existing scoreboards or poles are present.

Q5. Is there existing electrical service for these scoreboards? 120vac? What is available electrical current?

A5. Electrical service conduit to serve the scoreboards is in the scope of services of the general contractor, Charles Black Construction, who is constructing the park. The scoreboards are served from a 20A/1P circuit breaker at the panel by 120/240v through #10 direct burial cable to a non-fused disconnect at the scoreboard location. The electrical service up to and including the disconnect is part of the general contractor's scope. The scoreboard, mounting posts, and electrical installation to tie back to the disconnect provided (by others) is to be included in the pricing of this bid.

- Q6. Access to the baseball fields: Can a car or pickup truck be driven close (say 20 feet or so) to the installation locations?
- A6. Yes. The proposed scoreboards are shown beyond the outfield fences and these locations should be accessible by vehicle.
- Q7. Are there scoreboards in place now that are being replaced? If so, is the removal & disposal of the existing scoreboards part of the bid? Any pictures of the existing?
- A7. No existing scoreboards – this is new construction.
- Q8. If not & these are new scoreboards on new posts. Is there a layout showing how many poles are required & overall height of the scoreboards?
- A8. Each scoreboard will be supported by 2 poles. The outfield fence will be 10 feet high. Scoreboards will need to be installed above fencing so that it can be read clearly.
- Q9. Who is providing the foundations and I beams to hang the score boards for the baseball fields or are they existing? If existing, do you have dimensions and /or drawings/photos of them?
- A9. No existing poles. The awarded vendor of bid will provide poles/I-beams.
- Q10. Will the school be supplying and installing the poles? If so, are they already in place?
- A10. No existing poles. The awarded vendor of bid will provide poles/I-beams.
- Q11. Will there be two poles per scoreboards? Distance apart?
- A11. Each scoreboard will be supported by 2 poles spaced to support the weight of the 14ft scoreboard.
- Q12. Can we visit the sites before submitting our bids to determine equipment needed for installation?
- A12. Yes. Monday through Friday, 8am until 5pm.
- Q13. Will the school provide electrical service to base of scoreboards?
- A13. Electrical service conduit to serve the scoreboards is in the scope of services of the general contractor, Charles Black Construction, who is constructing the park. The scoreboards are served from a 20A/1P circuit breaker at the panel by 120/240v through #10 direct burial cable to a non-fused disconnect at the scoreboard location. The electrical service up to and including the disconnect is part of the general contractor's scope. The scoreboard, mounting posts, and electrical installation to tie back to the disconnect provided (by others) is within the scope of Project Number 2018-PR-001.

Q14. I am quoting wireless controllers so no direct cable will be required. Is this ok?

A14. Yes, wireless controllers are preferred.

Q15. What is the planned completion date for the scoreboards?

A15. Scoreboards need to be operational no later than February 15, 2019.

Q16. Will our access for installation be limited to certain days/times?

A16. Monday through Friday, 8am until 5pm is preferred.

Q17. Do you have a specific color for the scoreboard cabinets? Black is standard.

A17. Black

Q18. Must our bid include "Optional Equipment & Upgrades" listed?

A18. If your bid includes optional equipment and upgrades not discussed within Section 2.0 Specifications or within Addendum #1, those must be listed as separate pricing.

Note: A signed acknowledgement of this addendum must be received by the White County Clerk and attached to your proposal response.
