MINUTES OF THE CALLED MEETING HELD

THURSDAY, AUGUST 19, 2010 AT 8:30 A.M.

The White County Board of Commissioners held a Called Meeting on Thursday, August 19, 2010 at 8:30 a.m. in the Board of Commissioners Office Conference Room. The purpose of the Called Meeting was to enter into Executive Session in order to discuss potential acquisition of real estate. Present were: Chairman Travis Turner, Commissioner Joe Campbell, Commissioner Craig Bryant, County Manager Carol Jackson, and County Clerk Shanda Smallwood.

Upon a motion made by Commissioner Bryant, seconded by Commissioner Campbell there was a unanimous vote to enter into Executive Session in order to discuss the future acquisition of real estate. -See the Following Closed Meeting Affidavit-

During the Executive Session, the Board of Commissioners agreed to evaluate potential properties available for purchase in the Telford-Hulsey Industrial Park for the construction of the White County Detention Center. These properties included land owned by Dennis Greene on Cobb Vantress Drive & Industrial Park Drive (two separate properties) and land owned by John Hulsey off of Corporate Drive. The Board of Commissioners asked Carol Jackson to obtain information on the possibility of purchasing approximately eight (8) acres on either of these three (3) tracts, advising of any restrictions associated with these properties, and utility services to each tract.

Upon a motion made by Commissioner Bryant, seconded by Commissioner Campbell there was a unanimous vote to exit Executive Session.

Upon a motion made by Commissioner Campbell, seconded by Commissioner Bryant there was a unanimous vote to adjourn the Called Meeting.
